
INSTRUMENT TRANSPOSITIONS

- ★ Flute, oboe, bassoon, trombone, baritone B.C., tuba, and percussion are all C Instruments C Instruments play the same pitch as the concert pitch called.
- ★ Clarinet, bass clarinet, tenor saxophone, trumpet, and baritone T.C. are B-flat Instruments. B-flat Instruments go <u>UP two half-steps</u> to find their note from the concert pitch called.
- ★ Alto saxophone and baritone saxophone are E-flat Instruments.

 E-flat Instruments go **DOWN** three half-steps to find their note from the concert pitch called.
- ★ Horns are F Instruments.
 F Instruments go <u>DOWN</u> five half-steps to find their note from the concert pitch called.
